Snapshot of decisions made during the CCAPP Board Meeting and Annual General Meetings on June 22, 2018:

- The CCAPP Board meet in Toronto on June 22, 2018 to conduct its annual Board Meeting and AGM.
- Strategic decisions from the meeting included:
 - The adoption of vision statement for CCAPP: To be a world leader in pharmacy and pharmacy technician program accreditation
 - The modification of the CCAPP mission statement to: The Mission of The Canadian Council for Accreditation of Pharmacy Programs is to grant accreditation awards to pharmacy and pharmacy technician programs that meet the Standards set by CCAPP and to promote continued improvement of those educational programs
- Accreditation decisions from the meeting included:
 - University Programs: University of Montreal was awarded 4 years for their entry to practice PharmD degree program
 - Pharmacy Technician Programs: CDI Edmonton, Mohawk College, New Brunswick Community College (Saint John) , Selkirk College, Stenberg College (Surrey, BC) and Keyin College (Grand-Falls-Windsor all received accreditation awards
 - International University Programs: Qatar University received a 5 year International award for their BSc Pharmacy and PharmD degree programs
 - Upcoming site visits for the fall include: University of Manitoba, Keyin College (St.John's), CTS College (North Bay), Westervelt College, Centennial College and the College of the North Atlantic
- Stakeholder Relations:
 - The Board received a presentation from CPhA on their Recommendations for Scope of Practice Advancement and Harmonization
 - President Whissell provided an update on recent meetings held with PEBC, CSHP, NAPRA and AFPC
 - Liaison reports were received from NAPRA, CPTEA, CSHP, AFPC, CPhA and PEBC
